Everybody Has Something to Offer!

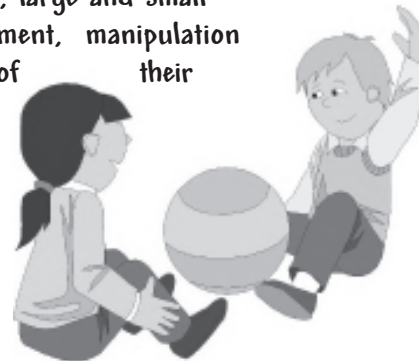

Our Philosophy

Therefore, in a creative, loving and challenging environment designed especially for preschoolers, children are met at their own developmental level and encouraged to identify and develop their gifts, and to grow and learn through faith, play, hands-on exploration, and experimentation.

Our Methodology

We believe that preschool children learn best, in a loving environment, through play. Therefore, each child is encouraged, during free play, to choose from a variety of developmentally appropriate activities. The child's learning is guided by his or her own active curiosity. Free play is a time for social interaction with peers and adults, problem solving, experimentation, creative expression, decision making, large and small muscle development, manipulation and exploration of their world.
